Four Questions To Ask Before Hiring A Stage Hypnotist

This article will make the process of securing a safe, suitable stage hypnotist for your event easier. It was written by request from event organizers. Consider printing this article out adding it in your organization party planning file.

Regardless of whether you plan the party yourself or secure an event planning company to plan the party, you should ask the following four important questions.

The reputable Stage Hypnotist will appreciate your questions, and you will be more relaxed knowing your securing the services of a professional. You will also be insuring your hypnotic show will be a success and your organization will have a fun night they will remember for years.

The Four Questions You Should Ask:

1) Can you verify the hypnotist is insured?

The professional hypnotist will be insured with a liability policy. Request a copy to confirm the policy is not expired. The amateur will not typically make the investment to protect themselves, you or the students.

2) Does your state require the hypnotist is registered with the Department of Health, and if so, are they?

If a hypnotist is required to be registered varies from state to state. Some states require that hypnotists be registered in many different areas, such as the Department of Health, while other states have no regulation over hypnotist. Check your state and make sure that if the hypnotist is supposed to be registered with the state, they are.

3) Has your hypnotist been professionally trained?

A stage hypnotist should have received professional training and be a member of stage hypnosis organizations such as National Guild of Hypnotists. A professional is committed to continued education and can be trusted to present a safe, flawless show without any problems.

4) Does the hypnotist have a demo video and track record? View the demo video, read the letters of recommendations and know what you are purchasing.

Obviously, if they have little or no track record, you can be assured that you are receiving a show that is not tested and the quality and entertainment value will be low, or worse, a miserable failure.

A bad hypnotic show will leave your audience bored, unsatisfied and eventually walking out of the show and can bring your whole event down! Not what event memories are made of...

Answers determine the level of professionalism.

Answering these four questions will help you plan an event that is safe and fun. You will be more relaxed the night of the program and the months leading up to the program knowing you are hiring a professional stage hypnotist that your organization will enjoy!

If you find the Stage Hypnotist is deficient in any of these areas, it is a sure sign they may not be a full-time professional and there may be cause for concern.
